

HYAA TRAVEL TEAM PROTOCOL 2011

All HYAA travel teams are insured. They must present a certificate of insurance to the tournament's they enter.

When a team decides on a tournament (look online at ETeamz.com or LeagueLineup.com), they need to contact the HYAA Travel Team Director (Gerry DiMaso) and let him know so he can send an entry fee check. The manager of the team must fill out the registration forms and send the certificate of insurance as well.

The manager must then arrange with the tournament officials regarding scheduling, etc.

Once the team has entered all of the tournaments, they must collect checks from their parents, made payable to HYAA, to cover all the entry fees. This must be done as soon as possible.

Equipment such as helmets, practice balls, and bats are all the responsibility of the travel team coaches and parents. HYAA does not pay for equipment.

Uniforms are also the responsibility of the coaches and parents. HYAA recommends contacting Athlete's Alley (ask for Greg) and ordering uniforms. Payment would be made directly to the uniform supplier.

If a team wants to enter the district tournament, they must be prepared to be in full uniform on the field, be Rutgers certified, and have acceptable background checks. The district tournament has its own protocol and the HYAA Travel Director will work with coaches on submitting registrations.
