

HYAA 2019 Girls Lacrosse Program Overview REGISTRATION BEGINS ON FRIDAY, JANUARY 4TH

HYAA will offer 3 girls teams for the Spring 2019 Season as well as our K-2nd Clinic (a separate overview will be sent for clinic).

Team Program Offering:

- \$150 early bird registration starts on FRIDAY, January 4th and ends on Friday, February 1st.
 \$175 regular registration fee starts Saturday, February 2nd. Leagues do close so register early.
- Team Season starts week of March 1, 2019 and will continue up to the last week of May.
- Practices on Tuesday, Thursday, or Friday night. 2 per week.
- 10-12 games plus one tournament
- Coastal Lacrosse League Participant(CLL)

<u>**3**</u>rd-<u>4</u>th: <u>**Head Coach**</u>: <u>**Michael Flaherty**</u> The 3/4 playing experience is an introduction to the game of girls' lacrosse. The girls play 7vs7 on a shortened field. The officials are very supportive of this age level and incorporate teaching into their officiating duties.

5th-6th: Head Coach: Otto Betz At this level the girls will play full field/full squad lacrosse. This is a competitive level. All levels of experience are welcome. Practice is mandatory for playing time. **7th-8th: Head Coach: Howard Shallcross(Level II Certified Lacrosse Coach)** This level will play full field/full squad lacrosse. All levels of experience are welcome. Practice is mandatory for playing time. There will be a CLL squad and a 7th grade selects squad for girls who have higher level competitive game experience.

Equipment: All participants will be required to wear US Lacrosse Certified Goggles, Stick, Mouth guard, and cleats.

Team Uniforms: Girls who have their uniforms from last year will be able to use them again. For participants who want a new uniform or who have not played before, there will be a uniform order period (additional charge \$40).

Volunteers: HYAA is a volunteer organization. We encourage parents to participate in many ways. There is a specific need for assistant coaches to help the head coach manage practices and the sidelines during games.

The HYAA organization has moved to a TeamSnap registration process. TeamSnap is an online and mobile-enabled sports team management application that allows our league, coaches and parents a more efficient means of communicating schedules and team events. If you do not have a TeamSnap account, you will be asked to create one as you register (requires an email address and password). Please register using the online form found on our website's LACROSSE page (<u>www.HYAA.org</u>). EVERYONE MUST CREATE A FAMILY ACCOUNT and register your child(ren) on TeamSnap. You can pay online by credit card or forward a check to the HYAA office. If you pay by check, please make sure that you put your child's name and SPORT on the re line of the check or on a separate piece of paper when dropping off or mailing to the office (PO Box 49 Holmdel, NJ 07733).
